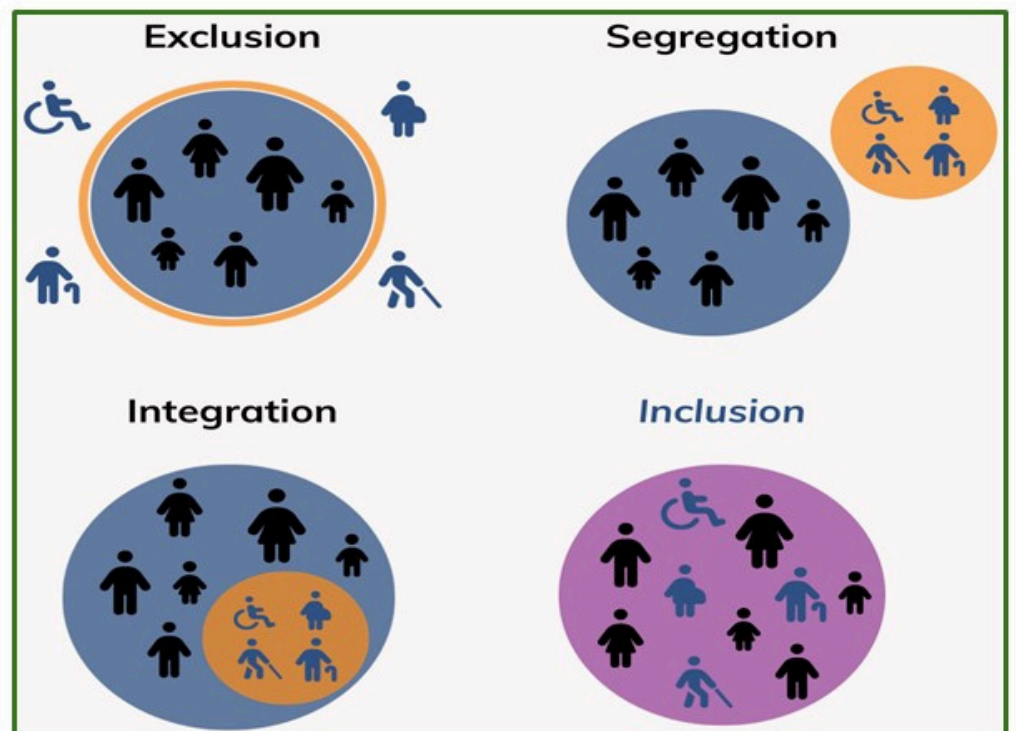

Educational Inclusion

In education “inclusion” has become the term used to describe the right of parents and children to access mainstream education alongside their peers, where parents want it and children’s needs can be met.

Integration, where the focus was on the child’s ability to adapt has been replaced by Inclusion. The focus for Inclusion is on the setting’s ability to adapt to the needs of the child, altering where necessary the way it works.



Navigating journey of inclusive education

Step one :Selecting an inclusive school for your child

Step two :Supporting your child to participate in an assessment of need

Step three : Identifying barriers that restrict your child's learning

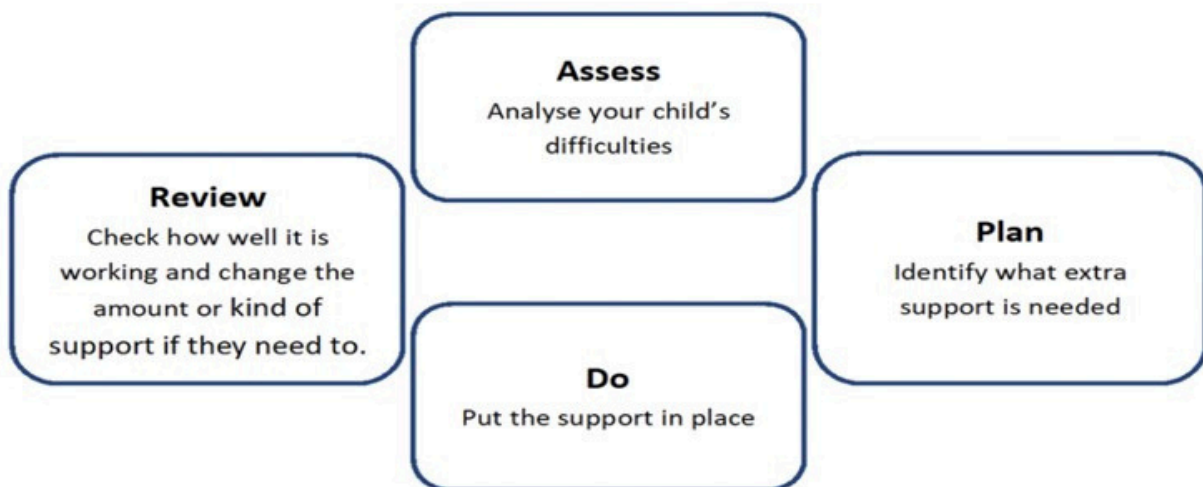
Step four : Implementing support to lower barriers to learning

Step five : Developing an Individual Education Plan (IEP) for your child and establishing an Individualised Service Agreement

Step six :Communicating about and contributing to your child's education

Supporting Pupils with SEND in the Classroom



Create a positive and supportive learning environment

- Teach children about well-being and mental health
- Introduce a class feelings board as part of your daily routine (visual aids are great for children with SEND!)
- Use social stories to model and encourage a positive attitude towards difference

Supporting Pupils with SEND in individual sessions

Create a positive and supportive learning environment

- Teach the student the lesson with different material .
- Show educational videos or powerpoint related to the lesson .
- Apply more worksheets related to the lesson .
